## INSTRUCTIONS

1)	Every student should install the “ <b>Aarogya Setu</b> ” app in their smart phone. Students should attend the college with the report for COVID-19 RT PCR / Rapid Antigen test done not before 20-11-2020.
2)	For day-scholars, it is preferably to attend the college by their own transport. However, the college buses will be provided, if sufficient number of students opts for this facility (students need to intimate college bus facility request in <b>NRIMC 2019 Whatsapp group</b> on or before 18 <sup>th</sup> November, 2020).
3)	Both Boys’ and girls’ hostels are open with all safety precautions and they are ready to be occupied.  Hostellers will not be allowed to move outside the college premises under any circumstances.
4)	All the students should enter into the college through “Triage” which is present in the main entrance of college (College Portico).
5)	At the Triage, students should maintain social distance and have their temperature checked before entering into their respective departments.
6)	Each student should wear face mask and hand-gloves and should bring their own hand sanitizer, water bottles and snacks (College cafeteria will be closed).
7)	Students should be observed the following instructions to prevent the COVID-19 infections. a) Physical distancing of at least 6 feet between persons. b) Mandatory use of face covers / masks. c) Frequent use of alcohol based hand sanitizers. d) Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one’s mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue / hand kerchief / flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly. e) Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest. f) Spitting shall be strictly prohibited. g) Sharing of items like notebook, pens/pencil, eraser, water bottle etc., amongst students will not be allowed. h) Students are strictly instructed not to gather in groups at any time in the college premises.
8)	Disciplinary action will be taken if any student is found violating the above safety instructions.
